## History

- 1963 Start of the production on July 18th;
- **1987** Reached 9000 tons per year maximum production volume in Soviet era. The number of employees approaches 3500;
- In 1991, the factory has been taken over by the Republic of Latvia as a state-owned enterprise;
- 1996 The privatization of the factory by attracting foreign capital. On October 22 that year, the owner of the German glass fibre manufacturer Glasseiden GmbH Oschatz, Jürgen Preiss-Daimler, signs the privatization agreement of "Valmieras stikla šķiedra" factory;
- In September 2001, a modern, one-stage glass fibre production facility is put into operation;
- 2006 the company opened new glass fibre facility;
- 2012 the company launched a new glass melting furnace with aim to produce glass fibre with high temperature resistance (1000°+C) using the latest and most advanced technology;
- 2013 Valmiera Glass UK Ltd;
- 2014 Valmiera Glass USA Corp.






