Doro's acquisition of Trygghetscentralen

Doro has today, April 15, completed the closing of the previously announced acquisition of the Norwegian Trygghetscentralen. The acquisition has been financed by existing cash and bank loans.

As announced on February 18, Doro Care AB has agreed with SOS International to acquire Trygghetscentralen. The deal was closed today, April 15. Trygghetscentralen will be consolidated in Doro Care's accounts from May 1.

The acquisition will enable increased efficiency in Doro Care's existing business in Norway. It will also offer potential synergies of scale and product supply.

Trygghetscentralen's current management team is staying.
