

DFDS AND LOUIS DREYFUS ARMATEURS STARTS DOVER-CALAIS ROUTE ON 17 FEBRUARY

Today DFDS and Louis Dreyfus Armateurs have entered into an agreement to call at Calais with the Port of Calais to start a new route on 17 February between Calais and Dover.

Initially the route will be serviced by one ship, the NORMAN SPIRIT, which since November 2011 has been deployed as a fourth vessel on DFDS' route between Dover and Dunkirk. In due course a second ship will be added to the new route.

More detailed information on the scope of the operation will follow when available.
